

BalletRox is seeking a part-time dance teacher and a potential teaching assistant for our BalletRox External Partners Program. BalletRox works with Boston Public Schools, private schools, and after-school programs. We are solidifying partnerships with Mission Grammar School and Wheelock Family Theatre, both in Boston, MA. We are proactively searching for teachers to help mold the schedule towards the teachers' availability. Please note that BalletRox is actively searching for more external partners for the upcoming school year. **We are also solidifying other partnerships and always open to knowing teachers' in or after-school availability, preferred age ranges, and genres taught in the event a future opportunity comes up that could be a better fit.**

The hours for the positions available are listed below. The pay will be \$60/hr for lead teachers and \$25/hr for assistant teachers. There are also benefits available to all teachers depending on working hours which can be discussed further with administration (PTO, EBHRA, retirement, etc.). Inclusive training for diverse students will be given to all teachers.

#### Mission Grammar School

- Twice a week from 3:30PM to 5:30PM on-site
- Most likely either Tuesday/Thursday or Monday/Wednesday
- K2 - 6th Grade
- Will also most likely be looking for assistant teacher for support

#### Wheelock Family Theatre

- Fall session from October 16, 2021 to November 20, 2021
- Preferable Saturday mornings/early afternoons
- Virtual classes for 3 ranges (6-8yrs old, 9-11yrs old, and 12+ yrs old) - more flexible with time
- In-person classes for 12+ (vaccinated) students
- Offering hip-hop, or a dance for the actor class--giving actors an introduction to dance basics/vocabulary--ballet, tap, and/or jazz--but open to discussion about other forms

#### Tasks include but are not limited to:

- Teaching dances lessons from a variety of dance genres that are inclusive and are reflective of the diverse student body
- Preparing dances lessons and class recitals at the end of the year
- Substitute teaching for other external partners classes
- Attending meetings with other BalletRox staff
- Monitoring student progress through individual student assessments at the beginning and end of the year
- Being flexible with multiple teaching offerings pending partner and local health restrictions (hybrid, in person, etc.)

#### Requirements:

- Strong interest in equity based dance education and promoting intersectional racial equity externally and throughout the organization
- High School degree
- Punctual and able to be proactive when needing coverage
- Knowledge and background of any dance genre (Tap, Hip hop, Jazz, Ballet, etc.)
- Must successfully complete a CORI form.
- Strong and independent work ethic
- Experience with teaching dance is appreciated, but open to professional dancers.
